#### Scripture: 1 John 1:1-9

We declare to you what was from the beginning, what we have heard, what we have seen with our eyes, what we have looked at and touched with our hands, concerning the word of life— this life was revealed, and we have seen it and testify to it, and declare to you the eternal life that was with the Father and was revealed to us— we declare to you what we have seen and heard so that you also may have fellowship with us; and truly our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ. We are writing these things so that our joy may be complete.

This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light and in him there is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with him while we are

walking in darkness, we lie and do not do what is true; but if we walk in the light as he himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he who is faithful and just will forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

### To reflect.

Today is the day when the church remembers John, Apostle and Evangelist. One of the first disciples of Jesus, author of the Gospel of John and the one thought to be the 'beloved disciple'. A Gospel writer – one who brings good news of the light of Jesus, one who we would have heard their Gospel at some point over Christmas bringing together Creation and the Nativity. Someone who was a witness to the adult Jesus' earthly ministry and walked the part of a Jesus-shaped life, changed forever in their interactions with Emmanuel, God with Us, the Light of the World. How are you illumined in your faith by the works of the apostle and evangelist John?

### Hymn to St John

O God, the eagle rises toward the Sun To spill the gospel out upon the night Made dark by sin and death until the Word Bore fire from heav'n to become our light. Saint John proclaims the light our very life, Our truth set free from our disfigured clay, Our path to glory flaming through the cross, The lamp to light our steps along the way.
