PERSONAL REFLECTION

One theme in the readings for the Fourth Sunday of Lent is God's faithfulness in drawing us closer. One theme for the readings for the First Sunday of Lent was God is faithful to us and humanity, even and despite us wandering away from God.

If you're looking at these materials as a group you're invited to share what that means to you. How do you see God's faithfulness in the world, to humanity and to you as an individual?

We are at a mid-point in Lent, with the Fourth Sunday being Laetare Sunday, a refreshment Sunday. How are you being refreshed in this Lenten season – in your faith, in your spiritual journey, in your relationship with God?

What does it mean for you to live and love the light? How does Jesus being light of the world impact you and your decisions this Lent and beyond?

What are the times where God has been faithful to you in your life, what are the praises that come from these instances?.

What does the foolishness of faith look like to you? Is this a term that makes sense to you or do you disagree with it as a term?
