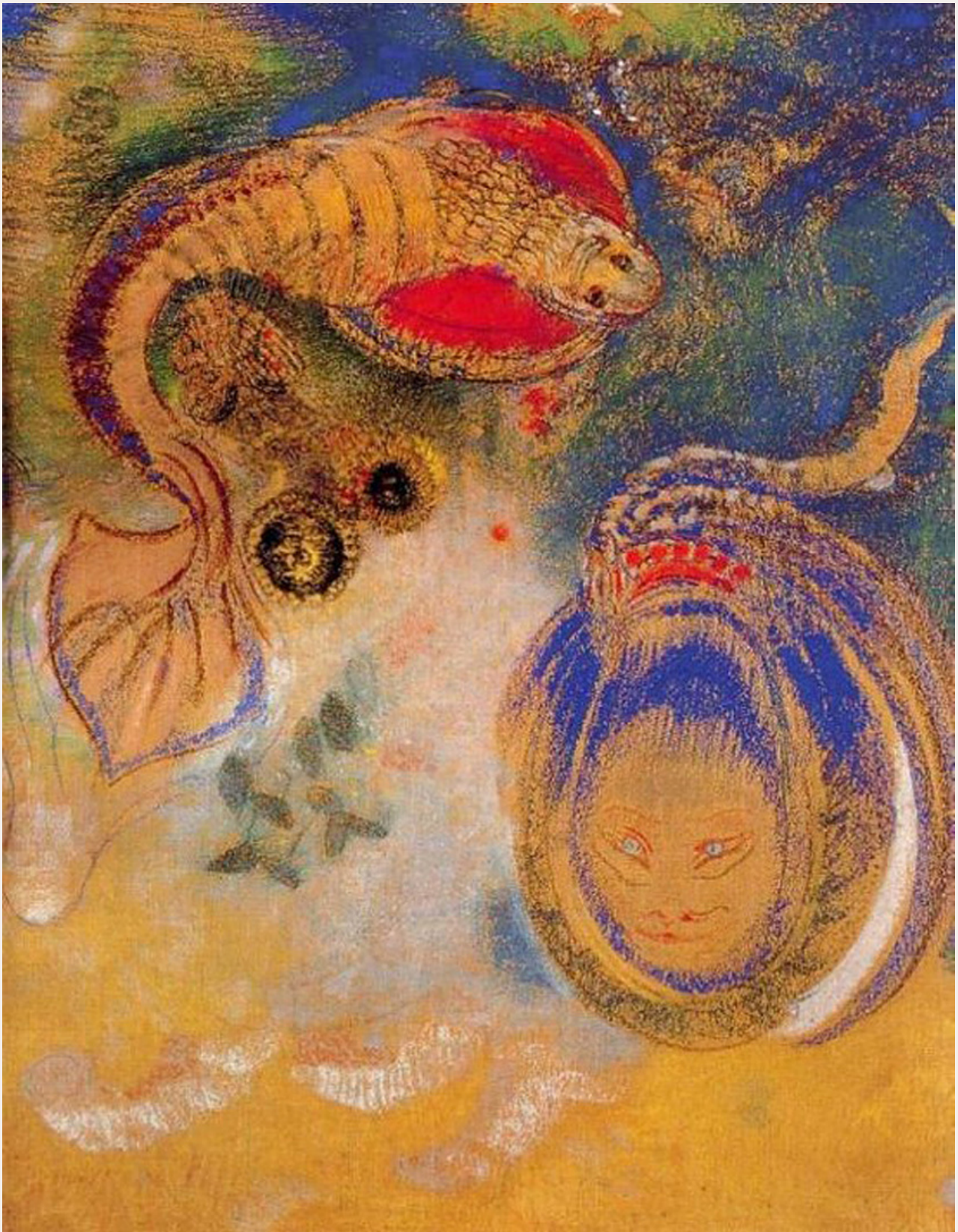
As you reflect on these images and pieces music what do they make you think about the theme of Community and faith
