

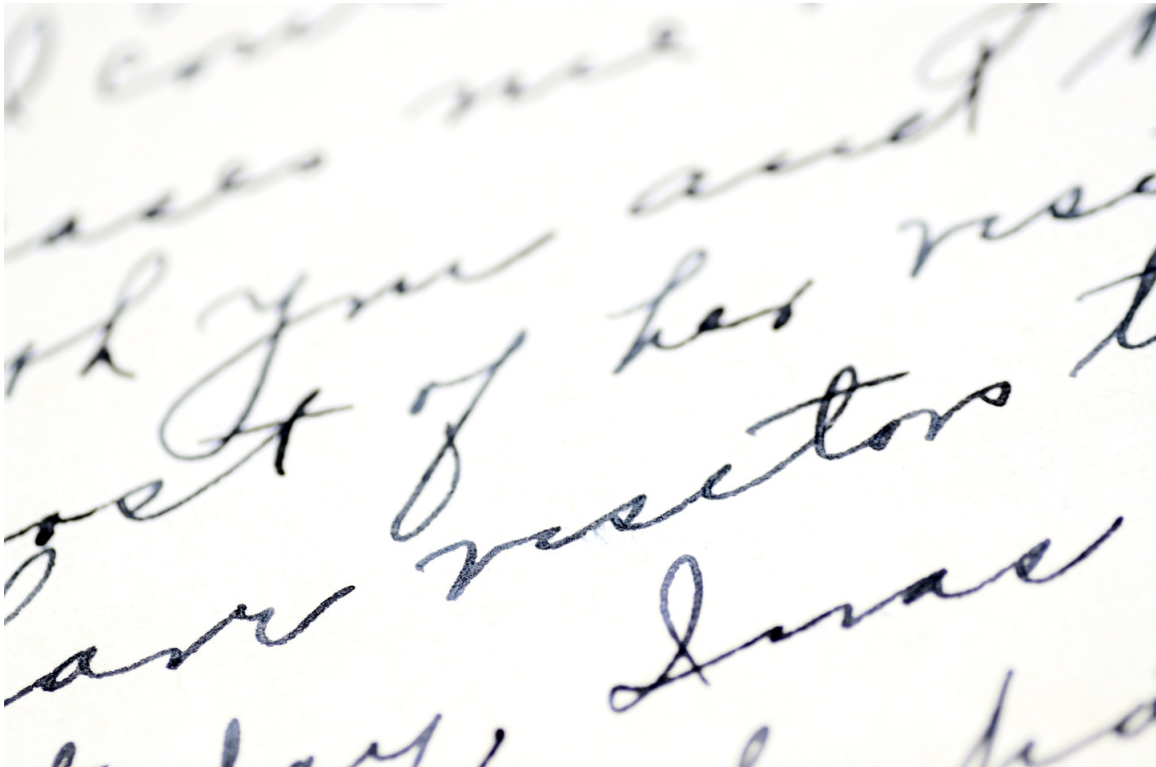


Words for Wondering

The Prophets (we spend time with Isaiah this Advent Season) are there to challenge and point the people of God to God.
