Reflection

Honour in the Bible often is used as a noun meaning "esteem, value, or great respect." In honouring someone is to value them highly or bestow value upon them. To honour someone is to value him highly or bestow value upon him. This is one of the Sunday's in Advent that you might hear the Magnificat where in the Eastern Orthodox tradition between verses, Mary is addressed 'You who are more to be honoured than the Cherubim and incomparably more glorious than the Seraphim, you who, uncorrupted, gave birth to God the Word, in reality the God-bearer, we exalt you.' What does honour mean to you this Advent?
