Scripture:

Matthew 3: 16-17

And when Jesus had been baptized, just as he came up from the water, suddenly the heavens were opened to him and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on him. And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, the Beloved, with whom I am well pleased."

Reflection

At Jesus' baptism we hear that the voice of God, the Father, calling Jesus (God the Son) the Beloved. This voice is also heard at the Transfiguration, reminding the disciples who Jesus is. We are also God's beloved - scripture reminds us that God has loved humanity since the beginning of time and Jesus is part of the never ending love of God for humans. Today you're invited to take a moment to reflect and revel in, being God's beloved child.
