*Scripture: **John 1: 37-40***

The two disciples heard him (John the Baptist) say this, and they followed Jesus. When Jesus turned and saw them following, he said to them, "What are you looking for?" They said to him, "Rabbi" (which translated means Teacher), "where are you staying?" He said to them, "Come and see." They came and saw where he was staying, and they remained with him that day. It was about four o'clock in the afternoon. One of the two who heard John speak and followed him was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother.

*Reflection*

One of the adjectives used to describe Jesus in his earthly lifetime as an adult was 'teacher'. We see stories in the Gospels of Jesus teaching people in all manner of way.
