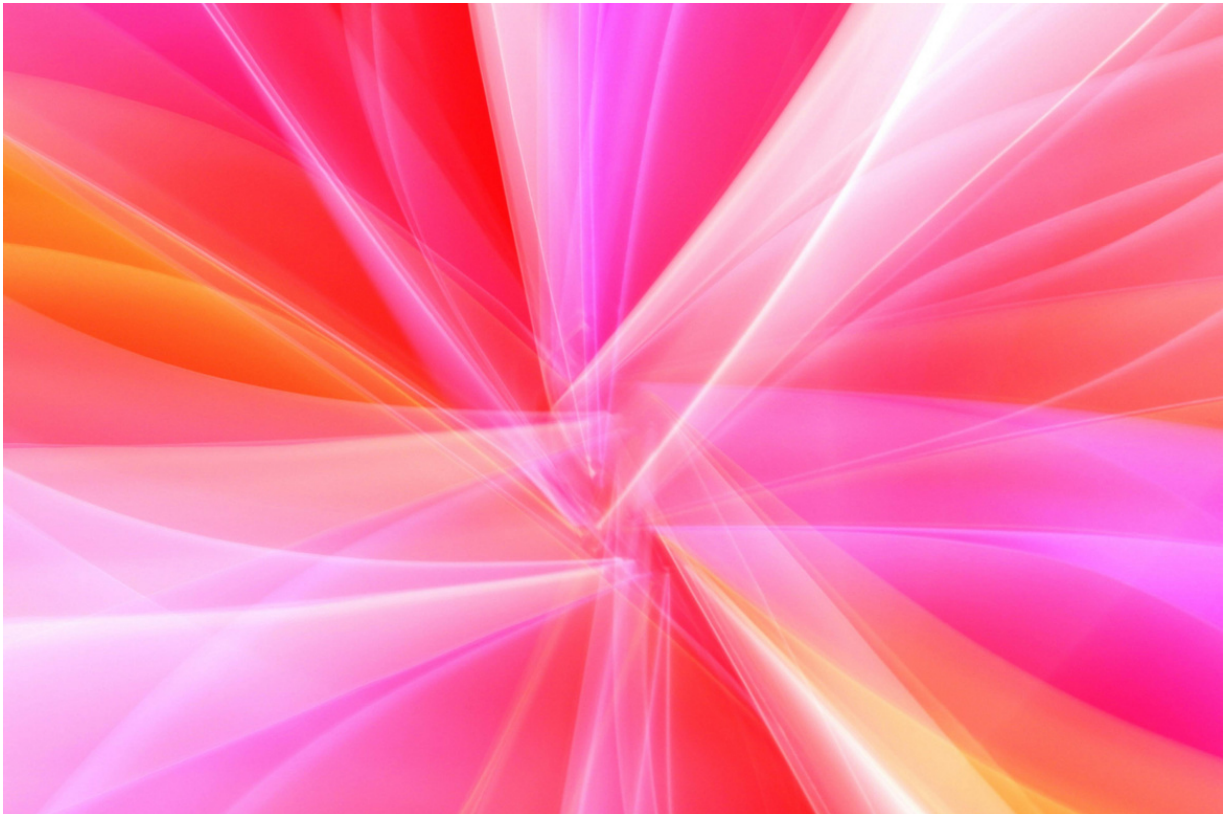




Words for Wondering

Scripture: **John 8: 12 - 14**

Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life." Then the Pharisees said to him, "You are testifying on your own behalf; your testimony is not valid." Jesus answered, "Even if I testify on my own behalf, my testimony is valid because I know where I have come from and where I am going, but you do not know where I come from or where I am going.

Reflection

The Collect for the Second Sunday after the Epiphany contains the words 'May your people, illumined by your word and sacraments, shine with the radiance of his glory'. We are called to be light to world, reflecting Jesus - the Light of the World. However, the collect asks that we are lit up, informed and inspired by God's word and the sacraments in order to shine with the radiance of God's glory. How does your participation in sacraments (e.g. Baptism, Eucharist) illuminate your life?
