Scripture: **Matthew 4: 18-22**

As he walked by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea—for they were fishermen. And he said to them, “Follow me, and I will make you fish for people.” Immediately they left their nets and followed him. As he went from there, he saw two other brothers, James son of Zebedee and his brother John, in the boat with their father Zebedee, mending their nets, and he called them. Immediately they left the boat and their father, and followed him.

Reflection

When calling the first disciples Jesus called fishermen - calling them to fish for people. To assist in sharing the good news of God's love for them and for all. This is the calling of St Andrew, Scotland's patron saint and the calling of all of us. How might you be called to share the good news of God - Father, Son and Holy Spirit with the world today?
